FALL MIGRATION ON THE WEST COAST OF VANCOUVER ISLAND

September 5 – 9, 2017

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This west coast experience at the Bamfield Marine Sciences Centre provides unparalleled access to unique coastal, marine and rainforest habitats and exceptional species diversity.

Your adventure includes boat trips, experimentation and observations in the laboratory, presentations and field trips to beaches and a rain forest. You will examine the biotic and abiotic characteristics of the ocean while observing marine mammals and birds. Walk on beautiful beaches and explore the intertidal wonders including sandy shores, algae, tidepools, sculpted stones and sea stars. Ospreys, eagles and sea lions can often be seen in their natural habitat! You will hike part of the world-class West Coast Trail through a coastal temperate rain forest. Field trips, labs and workshops will be guided by on-site educators.

Don't be disappointed. Register early. Space is limited.

WEDNESDAY, SEP 6 – FRIDAY, SEP 8

Activities onsite at Bamfield Marine Sciences Centre include: slide shows, workshops about rainforests, plants, fungi, and survey techniques for birding and mammals, labs on introduction to Barkley Sound invertebrates, and examination of plankton, sea birds and fish form and function. Field trips include beach and forest walks, bioluminescence discovery, and open water exploration of birds and mammals. There will be activities every morning, afternoon and some evenings. All meal times at BMSC are fixed. Breakfast is served daily from 7:30 – 8 am, lunch from 12:30 – 1 pm and dinner from 6 – 6:30 pm.

Please note that the site is not wheelchair accessible and participants will be faced with physical challenges such as stairs, hills, getting on and off a boat, beach walking and easy to moderate hiking trails.

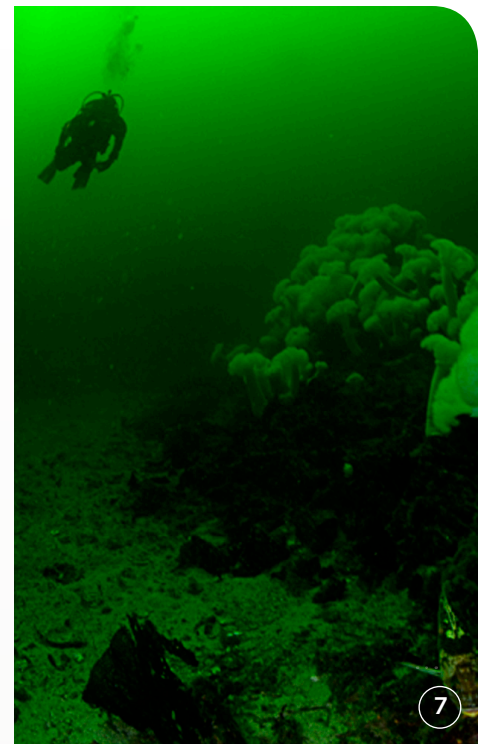
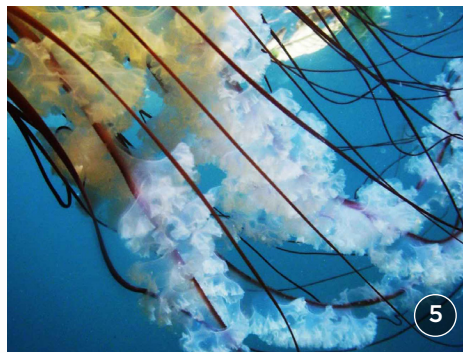
SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 9

All fees are based on double occupancy. Please note that accommodation is university dorm style shared accommodation with two people per room. Costs include bus transportation from Comox Airport to Bamfield Marine Sciences Centre return, accommodation, and meals as listed in the itinerary. Participants are responsible for transportation to Comox. A deposit of \$500 is required with the registration form. There is a \$200 withdrawal fee prior to the final payment dates. Final payment is due on July 14, 2017. Fees are based on the information available at the time of print and are subject to change to reflect any changes in currency rates, airfares, or land costs. There are possibilities of decreases or increases, and any changes will be reflected on the final payment and passed on to the participant.

Refund Policy

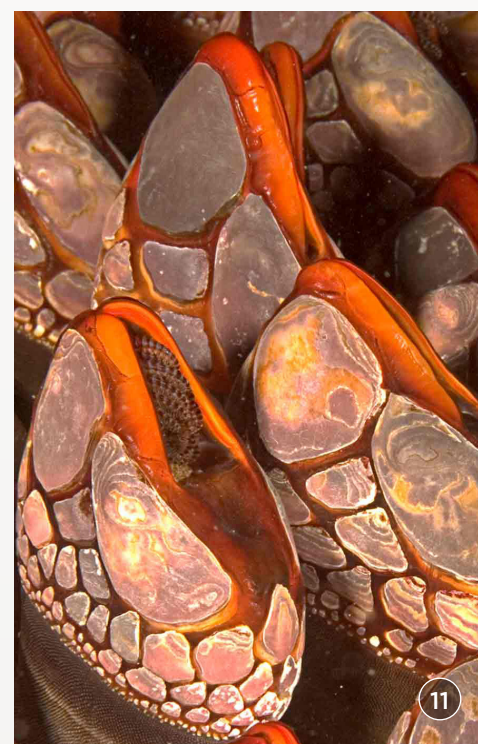
